

Sample Collection Procedure

- 1. Take the sample from the sheep you wish to have tested, and with an indelible pen, mark the sample collector with the animal ID.
- 2. Complete the order form and request a copy of the results be sent to BCSS.

PLEASE NOTE - when returning sample collectors to the Society, please ensure they are securely packaged in a jiffy envelope to prevent damage/loss occurring during transit.

To help members get the discounted rate for volume we will collate them and send as one batch to Agrobiogen. Breeders will still receive an individual certificate for each animal, but the combined submission will only be charged one £5 fee.

Costs and Invoicing

To help with the process of euro payments to Germany, BCSS will pay Agrobiogen direct, and then invoice members as below (all costs + VAT).

Sample collectors £2.00

Agrobiogen Handling Charge £5.00 each order.

Applicator hire £4 for 2 weeks -or- purchase £30

Genotype test: 1 - 10 samples £13.00 each 11 - 50 samples £12.00 each

51 - 99 samples £11.00 each 100+ samples £10.00 each

Timetable for Results
