CEO Report JONATHAN BARBER



Last year turned out to be more difficult for commercial sheep farming than I and many others had hoped. Based on returns in the first quarter, which were up 13.5% there was a degree of positivity for the remainder of the year. However the remaining $\frac{3}{4}$ were dismal with returns 19% down for most. Throughout May to September I listened to stories of sheep businesses' returns being between £5k to £30k down. They were not complaining, were disappointed not to be rewarded correctly for their hard work. Towards the end of the year I expressed my concerns to industry bodies and the media, not to moan, but to make our consumers aware that sheep farmers were also in the doldrums along with pigs, dairy and arable.

In the last $\frac{3}{4}$ not only was the price/kg down but we produced and sold an extra 1.5 million lambs (worth £110 million) for the equivalent of nothing. In comparison with 2014, when there should have been £200 million to circulate there was £0.

That picture had a depressing effect on all of us.

The Society's surplus was better than we had budgeted for. This was achieved by continuously responding to market forces. We moved reserves into stocks and shares and even though equity values on average has decreased, our dividends were up. The exchange rate gave us an increased margin on genetic testing in Germany. Ceres Solutions reduced its management fee. These all helped to counter other elements.

The breed continues to improve; both in its genetic performance and the way it is presented to purchasers, whether at home from the farm at Society sales or at local market sales around the UK. We certainly continue to achieve the challenge of "good genetics with good looks" in the show rings winning an interbreed title at all the major shows. Our survey of commercial Charollais ram users, which is on-going, tells us that we are on the right track. We need to go down the track a little further to satisfy concerns over perceived or real hardiness in Charollais x lambs at lambing time, especially in difficult weather conditions. Many farmers using Charollais do not have a problem and

are very happy with ease of lambing, lamb vigour and ability to get and go and suckle. We're great on tugging (see front cover), growth and carcass quality. The latter is determined by matching the right Charollais ram with the right ewe breed.

We are aiming at more PR and Promotion in 2016, setting off with marketing Charollais via an internet portal in conjunction with Sell My Livestock.

We will be helping you reduce your production costs by linking up with Anglia Farmers buying group who collectively purchase £250 million worth of services and products for their members and users.

We are setting up a Charollais Youth Focus Group for the UK (18-30) to work together to deliver ideas and contributions, of how they wish to see the breed develop now and over the next 10 years.

My thanks to everyone who has contributed to the Charollais world over the last 12 months and in particular to Andrew Walton who retires after six years as Chairman of the Central region, but who continues to support the breed in many other ways.

North Country Mule ewe lambs do the job

Carroll Barber reports on prize-winning stock from Skipton Market



Gareth Daniels from Little Barningham, Norfolk is a regular purchaser at Skipton Auction Market for their North Country Mule sales in the Autumn. In 2015 he was asked to judge the pen of 10 mule ewe lambs and backed his judgement by bidding the top price of 200 gns/ head for the Champion Pen of 10. Further bids ensured the total consignment going back to Norfolk was 100.

At the end of the sale Gareth was delighted to find out that the top bid of the day had earned him a £100 voucher from the Charollais Society to spend at their sale of rams the following week. He duly made the trip back up to Skipton for the sale and purchased not only the Champion, but also the Reserve Champion on the day.

First tup bought was a shearling ram from the Moss Side flock of Mark Worthington, Bury and the

second was a tup lamb from the Wraycastle Flock of J A Geldard & Sons, Cumbria.

“I stock up each year with some North Country Mules from the NEMSA sales and pick out the better-grown types that are strong enough for tugging.”

Gareth runs a total of 1,150 breeding ewes on his farm. 500 ewes are lambed in mid-December for the early lamb trade, then 150 Texel ewes followed by a further 500 ewes in late March/early April. The ewe flock is a mixture of North Country Mules, Suffolk x Mules, Texel x Mules and Charollais x Mules. The rams on the farm are expected to do a double stint of work and most end up serving between 100 - 130 ewes apiece.

“I have used Charollais tups for about 12 years and always found them terrific workers and

they certainly survive.”

Upon arrival at the farm the group of 100 mule ewe lambs were set stocked on parkland a few miles from the farm.

“I was lucky enough to get a new grazing agreement on 350 acres of fenced parkland, just a short way from home. The land had only had cattle on for many years, so was clean pasture for the sheep. This is where the mules have been all the time.”

To keep the ewe lambs growing on during mating they have been fed 1/4 lb of ewe nuts each day. This was increased to 1/2 lb as they came up to lambing. “All but 2 of the 100 held in lamb, with a lambing percentage of 140%.”

Gareth has traditionally lambed in open yards around his house, but this year with this new land took the decision to lamb all the April lambers outside.

“The ewe lambs have been lambing down really well, they are great mothers and stick with their lamb and with the Charollais there are very few problems at birth and the lively lambs are up in no time at all.”

Ewe lambs that have twins are picked up and taken back to the farm, where one lamb is taken off and fostered (if possible) or put on an artificial rearing system. “Most of the twins are on the milk machine as our lambing percentage in the older flock of ewes was 220%, so there

are just not any fostering opportunities.”

Gareth says that the lambs are perfectly hardy enough to be outside from birth and have withstood the pouring rain and cold winds that a Norfolk spring has thrown at them.

"The ewes find a spot out of the wind and you just let them get on with the birth. The lambs are up in no time at all and looking for their first drink."

The split in the lambing period gives not only the tups time for a break but allows Gareth and his wife Jo, who do all the lambing with some help from a veterinary student a much-earned rest.

EARLY LAMBING FLOCK

The aim with the flocks has been to cut costs where possible. With the early lambing only the single born lambs were fed ad-lib creep to get them away for the Easter lamb trade this year.

"With Easter being so early and the cost of feeding creep, I took the decision to turn the majority out onto turnips. Unless you are getting £5.50 - £6 per kg for those early creep fed lambs they are just not worth doing it that way. Having said that they have been doing well and another batch are now ready to go."

Gareth uses a mixture of tups over the flock; usually crossing back and forth different terminal sires. He also sticks with Suffolk tups on a number of mules for his replacement females.

"The Charollais go on all the North Country Mule ewe lambs, my home-bred ewe lambs, Texel x shearling ewes and a proportion of the early lambers.

I select my Charollais tups to give that easy lambing trait, lively lambs and fast growth. Over the years they certainly have a bit more head cover, which allows us to lamb outside with no problems."

Knockin Flock's Road to Success

Carroll Barber reports on the Knockin Flock in Shropshire.



A desire to be different led one young farmer from Shropshire to the Charollais breed and the results over her 10 years with the breed have been impressive.


Abbie Moseley farms with her father and mother at Knockin Hall Farm, near Oswestry. Ten years ago at the age of 15 Abbie was looking after the farm's store lambs which are finished on turnips and fodder beet each year. Inevitably some of the ewe lambs in the bunch proved to have been in-lamb and it was one of these sheep that attracted Abbie's attention. "She was very different from the rest of the group and gave birth to this cracking ram lamb. It turned out she was a $\frac{3}{4}$ Charollais and this certainly sparked my desire to find out more about the breed." Quite by chance a local Charollais breeder, Chris Crowther was visiting the farm to discuss farm machinery and learnt of Abbie's interest in Charollais. He soon brought her

a Year Book to study and that year there was a dispersal sale of in-lamb ewes from the Windmill Flock of John Davies at Worcester Market, Flock which Abbie and her dad Rob went along to.

"I had researched the terminal sire market; there were too many Texel breeders in the area and Suffolks were just not doing the job and I like to be a bit different, so decided to start up my own flock of Charollais." "Whilst my Mum and Dad have been very supportive of my new venture they would be the first to admit that they have little knowledge of the pedigree world so it was very much up to me to make it workmy investment, my responsibility."

The Knockin Flock was started with one Windmill ewe, two from Severn Gorge and one Knighton ewe from the sale. "I enjoyed lambing these ewes and the next year added 2 ewes and 4 lambs

from the Edstaston Flock of Robert Gregory. I had no experience of the management of breeding stock and Robert really took me under his wing to help with feeding, selection and management. It is quite a different skill set to produce a breeding tup or ewe from finishing a lamb for slaughter.” A further 3 females have been added to the flock from Aberkinsey and Rutland flocks but the flock has been built up from these foundation females and now stands at 50 ewes.

INFLUENTIAL SIRES

A number of sires have been influential in the progress and success of the flock. “In 2011 I decided to use Arjane Jumanji across all the ewes. This worked really well, not only was he a great sire but it gave me consistency in the progeny so I could establish a flock, rather than a selection of ewes. From that point onwards I was able to use a wider range of tups, but I felt it was a good way to start.” Another sire that has worked well in the flock is Rainbow Lindisfarne “I did not own this tup so was therefore limited to buying in semen, but he did nick tremendously well with the Jumanji ewes, so much so that I have retained a ram lamb, Knockin Pocket Rocket, bred this way for my own use.”

Abbie is clear on what she feels the Charollais has to offer the sheep industry “I look at our own 300 strong commercial ewe flock and identify the type of rams that give easy lambing, good growth, easy fleshing, tight skins and shape.” Abbie sells all her prime lambs from the flock and the bought-in stores through the live market at Oswestry and Welshpool. “I think it is important to be in the live-market with good quality lambs from your own tups, this helps market your flock to potential

customers and promotes the breed.” Abbie appreciates that there is variety within our breed but it adamant that you must work out what is important and stick to your own personal preference. “Although I appreciate comments on the hardiness of our breed, there is no doubt that the really solid, tight-skinned types do produce better finished lambs.”

SHOWING

Another route for show-casing the flock has been through the show ring. The flock has had some significant wins at shows, particularly with one ewe Knockin Lulu (11XXJ00017) a daughter of Arjane Jumanji, who took interbreed titles at two shows in 2015. Abbie has mixed feelings on the effect of showing on the breed. "I am concerned on the presentation and type of animals that are topping the shows. Trimming does take a huge amount of time and is hard work! Youngsters today trying to make a living from sheep often just don't have the time for this work and I would rather breed sheep with great natural finish, good skins and present them naturally – the majority of my tups are sold presented this way. Buyers can see what they are getting with no hidden faults."

The other issue is the scale of the breed in the show ring. "To compete at the top level the animals are just getting bigger and bigger with more bone; the commercial market does not need such large animals and we are in danger of losing our 'easy lambing' trait if we continue along this route" says Abbie. "On the plus side attending the shows is great fun; the Charollais members are a great group of people and always friendly, welcoming to new breeders and pleased to help."

LAMBING TIME

The Knockin Flock lambs in December and anything that is not up to standard gets culled out for the early lamb trade. "At 8 weeks of age I check all the lambs for correctness and those with faults and animals that I just don't like get culled. Getting £120 then is much better than hanging on to inferior stock and selling at low prices later in the year."

able to sell a few females at the Annual Saucy Sale in Worcester. "I always contact my buyers to see how they have got on with the sheep; tups or ewes. I need to know good or bad what they think of my stock and how they have performed; more customer service is vital for commercial success. This year for the first time a new young breeder was asking me for advice!"

SIGNET RECORDING

Two years ago the flock joined the Signet Recording scheme and Abbie is working away to achieve a greater understanding of the system and how best to implement it in her breeding programme. "My aim is to breed high performance animals that I like the look of; I have some high figures from Lindisfarne and also Dalby Malachite and have now used my home-bred tup Pocket Rocket to put more shape and tight skins into the lambs." His figures would back this up; not the highest on growth rate but in the top 10% for muscle and top 15% for CT muscularity. "I am fascinated by the CT scanning, you can see the whole animal and what is actually there in terms of fat, muscle, bone and gigot shape. Pocket Rocket was put through the scanner and this gave me confidence to use him as my stock sire." Abbie is looking for a balance between eye and figures, "I would never keep an animal I did not like just because its figures were high; nor buy a ram without first being attracted and satisfied with its physical appearance."

COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS

Abbie's commercial customers are the mainstream income for the flock and where she concentrates her breeding policy. "Many of my ram clients are



from Wales and use the tups on Welsh Hill ewes; they want easy lambing and lively, hardy lambs. I don't receive any negative feedback on lack of hardiness from this cross; I always talk to customers and try to suggest the most suitable ram for their farm." "I have had a few buyers move away to cross-bred tups, it seems to be the fashion at the moment, but in time they realise that the growth rate is just not there and already they are

animals they are purchasing are 100% bona fide Charollais,” said Mrs Barber. “Uncertainties are removed from both sides of the buying-selling equation.... everybody wins.”

The Charollais Sheep Society has come a long way since Boxing Day 1976 when Mrs Barber and her husband Jonathan’s family imported the first five Charollais ewes into the UK from France. The society was formed the following year and the breed has flourished.

There is a certified UK population of 60,000 pedigree Charollais, with 14,000-16,000 lambs registered each spring. The society is run by Ceres Solutions, from Jonathan and Carroll’s farm offices on their mixed farm outside Wymondham Norfolk, where they keep a flock of 125 registered Charollais ewes.

Across the country, breeding enterprises large and small belong to the society, ranging from half-dozen ewe starter units to flocks of 500, producing 300-plus rams per year.

The Charollais Sheep Society, the only EU-recognised body for breed registration in the United Kingdom, is dedicated to looking after the interests and needs of member breeders and their flocks. It promotes the breed at specialised sheep

events, county shows around the country, at agricultural colleges and in the media.

It also holds judging and selection workshops – and maintains the all-important national flock book register and issues registration certificates.

The Charollais Sheep Society partnership was warmly welcomed by Andrew Loftus, commercial director of Sell My Livestock.

“Sell My Livestock has grown rapidly since we launched it two years ago. We now have a group of companies operating internet-based agricultural trading platforms; 5,000 UK farmers are registered with us already.”

The one-stop-shop site has around 2,000 sheep offered for sale on any given day – and around 60% of everything listed is sold. Since its launch, Sell My Livestock has successfully marketed tens of thousands of sheep.

Mr Loftus predicted the new link will offer good value to Charollais Sheep Society members.

“A web-based sales option has several advantages. It is less stressful for the animals as there are fewer movements in the sale chain, typical transaction costs

are less, and there is a vastly expanded marketplace,” said Mr Loftus.

“We have a big social media presence – one lot of yearlings we posted for sale on a Friday recently had been viewed 5,000 times by Monday.”

Mr Loftus also stressed that Sell My Livestock does not see itself in direct competition with livestock markets; rather, the modern platform is complementary to the traditional route to market.

“There is room for both – and we are seeing a growing number of traditional livestock markets and auction houses making use of our site for their own sales initiatives,” said Mr Loftus.

Quality and Dedication Pays at Raucedby Farms - Carroll Barber reports

Quality stock and a high level of stockmanship ensures one Lincolnshire sheep enterprise is certainly profitable.

Richard Ward has been farm manager of Raucedby Farms, near Sleaford for the past 34 years and sees the 1,200 ewe flock as a key component of the 1,600 acre estate.

“The farm is mainly arable but as the mixed soil types include some blowing sand there are areas on which permanent pasture is really the best

solution. The estate also has a stunning Jacobethan style hall surrounded by 250 acres of parkland, which is ideal for the sheep flock. I also like working with sheep and together with one full time shepherd, a full-time tractor driver and some night-time lambing assistance we cope with the workload. “

NORTH COUNTRY MULE EWES

The ewe breed of choice is the North Country Mule with which Mr Ward is highly satisfied with. “We purchase ewe lamb replacements each year; in 2015 we bought 200 and these all go

to the tup as lambs.” The stock are all purchased from one farm in Yorkshire and this policy has reaped benefits in terms of the health status of stock being brought onto the farm. The flock has no problems with abortion or foot infections, which is a huge plus in terms of productivity.

The adult ewes start lambing in mid March and this ends with the ewe lambs by mid/end of April. “We have some historic listed farm building on the farm, which only get used once a year for the lambing period. Although practically they might take a bit of care when mucking out, they provide an excellent environment for lambing ewes.” The farm follows a high level of husbandry at this time with great attention to detail in hygiene and management of the new-born lambs. This year this stockmanship has resulted in over 190% lambs turned out.

“We like to look after our stock well; it gives you great pleasure to turn out fit healthy lambs and also the bottom line reflects the high output of the flock.” All the ewes are lambed inside, ▼

put into hardening-off pens outside and then moved to pasture after a few days. “We aim to keep the groups in age batches so we can be most effective with worming, injections etc.” The ewe lambs are all kept separate for ease of care and any twins taken off and sold as cades. “We usually have grass until November and then the flock is fed on forage crops up to lambing.”

CHAROLLAIS RAMS

Charollais rams have been a feature of the tup team for many years. “I tried a couple many years back, was pleased with the results and have kept with the breed. We run a mixture of Charollais and Texel, but the ewe lambs are all mated just to the Charollais.” Again Mr Ward prefers to buy straight off farm and visits local breeders, Ruth and Tom Mawer to select from their Kelby Flock. He has been up to Aberdeenshire and purchased stock at the on-farm sale of the Ingram Family. “I read an article about the family and their sheep enterprises and was keen to take a look. I don’t want a ram that has been pushed too hard and was attracted by the grass-reared and naturally presented policy of their sale.”

“We like the Charollais cross Mule lambs; they lamb easily and are a very lively lamb up and suckling straight away. It saves a huge amount of time and effort if the lambs will get on and thrive themselves.”

The lambs are not pushed during the spring / summer and

are sold in the autumn off catch crops. “On our very light land we can go dry and lose grass in the summer, hence we need an alternative forage for the lambs. The farm is in a HLS environmental scheme so we incorporate some over-wintered brassicas into the plan which are perfect for finishing lambs



on.” Mr Ward is complimentary of the growth rate of the Charollais cross lambs which are faster growing than the other crosses on the farm.

NEWARK MARKET

All the lambs are sold live-weight through Newark Livestock Market and very often the tight-skinned Charollais cross lambs sell for more per kilo than others.

“Rauceby Farms produce a consistent quality of lamb that we find easy to market given the nature of the breed, weight, finish etc. of a commercial lamb. Buyers in the Market seek that and with a weekly supply sold via us are able to return week after week to source meat,” says James Sealey from Newark Livestock Market

Last year for the first time Mr Ward kept back 50 of their own Charollais x Mule ewe lambs which are now lambing. These have gone back to the Charollais some cracking meaty, tight-skinned $\frac{3}{4}$ Charollais lambs are being produced. “We will see how this cross works for us, but so far we like the ewes, and the lambs certainly have all the right qualities.”

7,000 gns top for Logie Durno Olympian.

Trade for Charollais rams at the breed's premier sale was buoyant and much on a par with the previous year, despite the gloom over prime lamb prices around the UK. Buyers were looking for well-grown tups with plenty of shape and muscle.

The Ingram family from Aberdeenshire were topping the trade with 7,000 gns for a shearling ram, Logie Durno Olympian. His sire was Crogham Lambert out of a Rockvilla Golden Promise ewe with a strong record of top-priced progeny.

The ram was reserve shearling ram in the pre-sale show classes and was knocked down to renowned Limousin cattle breeder, Mr Michael Alford from Foxhill Farm in Devon. Between the two flocks; Logie Durno and Loanhead the Ingrams achieved 7 out of 10 of the top shearling ram prices.

In the show classes the champion and reserve tickets went to another top stockman, Mr Myfyr Evans from Llanrhaeadr, near Denbigh. His powerful ram lamb, Rhaeadr Prospect took the Championship ticket and sold for 4,000 gns to McConnell Bros from Co Antrim in Northern Ireland. His sire was Wernfawr Neo out of a Parkgate Hurricane ewe.

The reserve award was also from

the Rhaeadr flock, this time a shearling ram Rhaeadr Orlando, also by Wernfawr Neo and out of a Parkgate Hurricane ewe. The Ingrams went to 5,000 gns to secure his services.





Premier Sale in Worcester and the National Suffolk Sheep Sale in Shrewsbury with ram lambs from his two pedigree flocks carrying the Rhaeadr prefix.

At the Charollais Worcester Premier Sale at the beginning of July, Myfyr won the Championship with ram lamb Rhaeadr Prospect and the Reserve Championship ticket with a shearling Rhaeadr Orlando, both animals were sired by Wernfawr Neo out of dams by Parkgate Hurricane. The rams then went on to sell for 4,000gns and 5,000gns respectively, with an average price £3,423.00 for his top five rams.

At the Suffolk National sale also taking place in July, Myfyr secured the Championship with a ram lamb by Rookery Best of the Best, he went on to sell at 6,000gns. However, another of the Rhaeadr lambs by Ardlea Arbennig topped that on sale day selling for the top price at 21,000gns. But, better was to come for Myfyr a week later at the Suffolk sale in Stirling, where he achieved a staggering 25,000gns, the sales top price. It had been quite a month for the Rhaeadr flock.

Great Year for Rhaeadr Flock

Emyr Hughes recounts the success of one Welsh Flock in 2015.

2015 was a year to remember for top Welsh pedigree stockman Myfyr Evans, he gained the unique accolade of winning the Championship at both the Charollais Sheep

Myfyr farms at Tan-yr-Accar farm, Llanrhaeadr near Ruthin, North Wales, with his wife, having taken over the business from his father. The holding itself comprises of 75 acres of grassland with a further 50 acres of land rented locally. 150 head, of which there are 90 Suffolk ewes and shearlings and 60 Charollais. This year a third sheep venture will be added, having purchased four Texel ewes last season.

Having been involved in pedigree sheep breeding since 1979 with Suffolks, Myfyr was keen to add a second flock to the business having gone out of dairy farming in 2004.

The Charollais seemed the ideal choice. “I liked the breed” says Myfyr “they have a good carcass, good skin and a real will to live, that’s the type of sheep we should all be looking for”.

Foundation Stock

The Rhaeadr Charollais flock was started with the purchase of one senior ewe and five yearlings from the now dispersed Penrhos flock of Brian Evans. “It was important to have a good foundation, and all of those ewes did well for us” says Myfyr.

When it came to building a solid foundation, one animal stands out for Myfyr, Parkgate Hurricane. The first stock ram in the Rhaeadr flock, was purchased for 4,200gns at the breed’s premier sale in 2007, he was the son of the highly influential Southam Exotic and bred by Herbie and Alan Kennedy.

“We used him heavily, and he produced some fantastic stock” states Myfyr “he left us some great stock ewes that have proved to be great breeders”. He was also Champion Stock ram in the Welsh Flock competition in 2008, when the Rhaeadr Flock became the Champion flock in Wales.

Another ram that had a big influence within the flock was Ballyhibben Klass Act, a ram that was purchased privately from Michael Power in 2009.

“He clicked really well with Hurricane daughters” says Myfyr “producing lambs with great bodies and tight skins”. His first pen of progeny at the Premier Sale in Worcester 2012 produced the Reserve

Champion Ram Lamb and Champion Shearling, with trade topping at 4,800gns and his twelve sons averaging 3,175gns.

This year saw the purchase of an exciting new stock tup, Knockin Pucker Up bought from Abbie Moseley for 4,400gns. When asked about his lambs Myfyr is quietly confident “his lambs are showing some real promise, they have great growth but its early days, it’ll be interesting to watch their progress”. I’m sure they will be worth a look at this summer’s premier sale.

Charollais Focus

When asked about where he sees the focus for the breed’s future, Myfyr states clearly, “We must focus on carcass, a good top, backend and most importantly set on four good legs. The rams have to work to produce good commercial lambs.” He is particularly keen to state that “if you don’t get the legs right, the sheep isn’t right.” It’s possible to see through the Rhaeadr flock an emphasis on these traits.

This year will also see the Rhaeadr flock offer only its second consignment of females for sale in the newly established ‘Cream of the Crop’ sale in Ludow on Sunday 2nd October. Many of these females will be from the same group of lambs that had proved so successful at the Premier Sale in 2015.

When asked about his other achievements in farming there is one moment that stands out for Myfyr. In 1994 at the Edinburgh Suffolk Society sale he sold ram lamb Rhaeadr Rossi for a staggering 70,000gns. This ram went on to have a massive

influence in the breed. “The following year over 100,000gns worth of sons were sold at Edinburgh” states Myfyr.



AHDB Awards 2016

TILTON FLOCK DELIGHTED WITH MOST IMPROVED FLOCK AWARD

The 2016 winner of the AHDB Beef & Lamb Better Returns Programme Improved Flock Award for Charollais sheep is the Tilton flock of Leicestershire, owned by Alan Thomas. This award is presented to the English Signet performance recorded flock that makes the greatest improvement in the breeding potential of the lamb crop during the year.

The AHDB BRP aims to highlight the financial impact that

improved breeding and better lamb selection strategies can have on commercial flock profitability.

This award seeks to reward those breeders that are using Estimated Breeding Values to enhance the performance of their flocks and assist them to promote their achievement. The impact of performance recorded stock is significant and is increasing every year because of the activities of progressive farmers.

BREEDING POLICY

Established in 1993 careful selection and a tight breeding policy of only keeping the highest quality true type Charollais Sheep has resulted in an excellent flock. The 150 ewes are split between two flocks.

Fifty are lambed in December and the lambs are reared indoors, these lambs are fed creep and undergo full performance recording. Most of the ewe lambs are retained for breeding but some stock are made available at pedigree sales and for private purchase.

MARCH LAMBING FLOCK

The remainder of the ewes are lambed in late March and the lambs are reared outdoors, these are weighed at eight weeks and the lambs stay with their mothers until weaning in August. These are typically sold as shearlings. Every year around 50 shearling rams and 30 ram lambs are available for purchase.

The Thomas family rent a 110 acre council farm and also have access to a 100 acres of summer grazing. The Charollais flock share the farm with a pedigree herd of Holstein and Guernsey cattle and the ram lambs are

Significant ram purchases of recent years include Sheldon On The Ball (14XNR00358) and Grange Morse (WDK:1201032) who has an index of 371.



RamCompare



First commercial progeny test for the UK

RamCompare was launched in May 2015, the UK's first commercial progeny test and will run over two breeding seasons until 2017. Around 6,000 slaughter lambs will have weights and carcase information recorded to identify which rams have the most profitable genes for commercial sheep production. For the first time there will be a direct comparison between the commercial performances of rams from five terminal sire breeds.

The project aims to help sheep producers identify which genes have the biggest impact on speed of finishing and carcase value, as well as identifying the degree of difference between breeding lines for new traits like saleable meat yield and tenderness.

What is RamCompare?

RamCompare involves a partnership of six commercial flocks and 14 organisations. Over two breeding seasons, 67 rams will be tested from five breeds producing 3,000 commercial lambs per year for data collection.

RamCompare is the first step in assessing the feasibility of running a commercial progeny test in the UK. It will help the sheep industry understand whether data collected from farms and abattoirs on cross-bred slaughter lambs can be used in genetic evaluations. The project will also enable the sector to examine how the performance of lambs from different terminal sire breeds compare under commercial conditions.



The six commercial flocks selected represent a range of UK systems, all are experienced EID users and each has provided a group of uniform ewes that are bred to produce commercial lambs. Each farm will hold an open event over the course of the project.

Data collection

On each farm, four ram breeds are used Texel, Suffolk, Charollais and either Meatline or Hampshire Down. 120 ewes are equally split between four artificial insemination (AI) sires and 200 ewes are split into five groups of 40 for natural

service using the same breeds; four new RamCompare sires and a fifth “farm choice” ram, enabling the flock to compare performance of new rams against their own farm stock ram.

On-farm EID data collection is crucial to this project with lambs tagged at birth and followed through to the abattoir, a range of data will be collected:

- Sire and dam information - To generate a pedigree and link related lambs together
- Date of birth - To calculate ages at weights and events
- Rear type (single or twin) - To ensure differences due to management can be accounted for
- Lambing ease - To monitor the impact of rams on lambing ease
- Deaths - To ensure deaths can be accounted for in the analysis
- Fostering information - To account for singles or triplets being reared as twins
- Birthweight - To act as a baseline for future weights
- Eight week weight (plus date) - To understand the impact of maternal ability on growth

rates

- 90 day weight (plus date) - To collect a weight at a similar age to standard weaning
- Ultrasound measurements - Around the 90 day weight, compare against the values from their sires
- DNA sample - Parentage/abattoir cross checks, with a proportion stored for future genomics work
- Sale weight - To be used to calculate killing-out percentage
- Carcase weight - To be used to calculate killing-out percentage
- Fat classification - To compare against the values from their sires
- Conformation classification - To compare against the values from their sires
- Saleable meat yield - On a proportion of lambs to relate back to sire's predictions
- Tenderness - On a proportion of the lambs to understand the variation that exists

Project outcomes

Currently EBVs of rams from different breeds cannot be compared directly. This project will enable rams to be compared irrespective of breed with the

development of a combined breed analysis. At the end of the project lists of the top 25 rams based on the growth rates and carcase data of their progeny will be compiled. Rams of different breeds can then be a compared directly.

Data from the project will be used in the future to develop new EBVs for days to slaughter and carcase weight.

Combined-breed evaluations

Combined-breed sheep genetic evaluations are currently available in several countries including Ireland, New Zealand and Australia.

AHDB Beef & Lamb is funding a project at Scotland's Rural College (SRUC) that will utilise RamCompare data to validate a new UK terminal sire evaluation. This combined-breed genetic evaluation allows multiple terminal breeds of sheep to be evaluated simultaneously and, where good genetic linkage exists, animals from different breeds can be compared via the resulting EBVs.

Ram selection

Rams used in the project are selected based on their estimated breeding values (EBVs) and breeding lines. Linkage between other flocks is important, especially for the rams destined for use by AI. A breeder can have up to two rams selected for the project and is paid a fixed fee for semen/rams.

Charollais sires used in year one

Two AI sires were chosen to cover 30 ewes each on three of the six farms, both will be used again this season on two more flocks.

“Wernfawr Magnum” was winner of the recorded class and supreme champion at the Worcester Premier Charollais Sale 2012. “Magnum” was sold for 5,200gns to the Wedderburn Flock belonging to J D R & J L Corbett. With over 230 progeny in at least 6 flocks, this stock ram has been a highly influential sire in the Wedderburn flock. By “Glantren Legend” out of a Coldharbour ewe – he combines a number of influential breeding lines.

NEW RECORD FOR BREED WITH DOUBLE INTERBREED DELIGHT FOR LEELAW FLOCK

It was a Highland Show to savour for the Leelaw Flock of Russell Gray from Lanarkshire, when he was triumphant in two Interbreed Competitions. This was a first for the Charollais breed, who won the Individual and Pairs awards at Scotland's Premier show.

Leading the show classes, under the experienced eye of Mr Jim Aiken from Northern Ireland, was Leelaw's shearling ram Oakchurch Ozil. The tup was

purchased from Jeremy Price from Hereford at the Worcester Premier Sale in 2014 for 550 gns. Interbreed Judge Ron Mackenzie from the Black Isle, described his champion as 'outstanding'. 
